Ok this is where I give you the juicy links and quick reminder info that I talked about in today's edition of the podcast. I'll keep this short and sweet so you can just use it as a reference when you need it.

Essential Facts

Key Fact – Remember that Narita airport is roughly 60 or so km away from the city center. You will need to fill out your disembarkation card – back and front – ready for when you get to immigration.

Fingerprinting and taking your photograph are mandatory. You can argue as much as you like, if you want to enter the country this is something you've just got to do :)

Traveling with large or heavy bags is not that easy in Japan, especially on public transport. Trains are crowded, luggage areas are few and far between, and there's lots of walking with stairs and up and down to get you from platform to platform. I strongly recommend sending your luggage on ahead of you using the baggage delivery service that is in the arrivals hall at Narita airport. You can also do the same when you are heading back to Narita airport from your hotel or lodging.
